Open T & F 9 am – 12 pm	Our grocery pick-ups started out small but have been increasing and we expect them to continue to climb as layoffs and furloughs become more wide-spread and this goes on longer. So far we have been able to handle the number. We have been able to provide for the most part. We've not had anyone ask for anything that we haven't had or any special needs or requests. We are getting food from St Louis Area Foodbank as normal and Operation Food Search. Our grocery pick ups started out small but are increasing. Where we lack in items is good produce, dairy, boxed foods, and pasta sauces. We would normally purchase the boxed food and sauces but are not able to because of the grocery stores not being able to keep their shelves stocked. We are doing fine on protein items. Donations of baked goods and bread has increased.
