Increasing Capacity and Accountability**Katie Kaufmann**

- A Culture of Trying
 - Katie discusses the idea of a new sense of community and that individuals need to learn new things and generate new ideas. The idea that you are here because you are somebody is somebody who is involved in trying and we should keep pushing each other and holding each other accountable.
- Core Function
 - Recap of purpose the RRT, which is to build a centralized system of response for our region.

Eviction Prevention Campaign Update

- **St. Louis City** **Wil Pinkney**
 - Molly gave updates on eviction prevention in the city. The city will receive a little bit less than \$9million and there are currently 2,000 families on the waiting list to receive these funds.
- **St. Charles, Warren and Lincoln County** **Todd Barnes**

- There is recent support in place for landlords in St. Charles, Lincoln and Warren County to assist them as they navigate through all of the necessary documentations.

- **St. Clair County**

- There is no current formal structure in St. Clair County that provides direct assistance to landlords. St. Clair county continues to follow the executive order that was issued by their Governor. That has placed moratorium on evictions until February 6, 2021.

- **St. Louis County**

- St. Louis County to receive close to \$30 million in resources.

- **Madison County**

- Madison County recently applied for funding and was granted \$7.8million dollars. There will be two different avenues for residents to receive funds.
